Market Harborough Youth Netball Club Toilet Visit Policy

We request that all players visit the toilet before attending their netball session.

All ages up to and including U12

Players must be in pairs and accompanied by a coach or support coach to go to the public leisure centre toilets.

Ideally, this accompanying person is a DBS checked adult support coach, leaving the lead coach in the dome with the players.

Players must not be left in the dome without a qualified adult coach, so if the only option is an U18 support coach to take the young players to the toilets, this can happen, but the helper must remain outside of the toilet block.

If players are at a young age (expected U8 but possibly older depending upon the child) and require the support coach to go into the toilet block with the players, this must be a DBS checked adult support coach.

No member of the club – child, adult, player or coach is allowed to enter a toilet cubicle alongside anyone else and close the door.

All players from U13 to U18

Any toilet visits must be taken in pairs.

Players are expected to move at pace to the toilets, visit the facilities and return to the training dome as quickly as possible.

Players must stay together at all times, but use separate toilet cubicles.

Players should report anything unusual to the leisure centre staff or coaching staff immediately upon their return.

Players are requested to bring enough water for the full session. If a visit to the water fountain is required, the same rules as for toilet visits applies. If acceptable within the covid guidance at the time, a support coach or youth helper should go to fill water bottles if possible.
